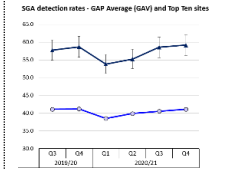

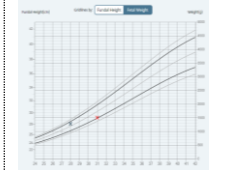
National GAP User Symposium – Thursday 15 July, 09:00- 16:00
