

#YouAreNotAlone	<ul> <li>The Perinatal Institute is supporting Baby Loss Awareness Week 9-15 October 2020</li> <li>We are continuing our efforts to improve safety and quality in maternity care.</li> <li>While there are still too many preventable deaths, there has also been good progress.</li> <li>We present an update on national stillbirth rates and the Growth Assessment Protocol (GAP), which is running in near 80% of all NHS Trusts and Health Boards in the UK.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Stillbirth rates in England continuing to fall</li> <li>Latest ONS data (to 2019) show a decline in stillbirth rates to 3.83/1000</li> <li>This represents a 28.4% reduction compared to the previous 10 year average, and the prevention of over 1000 stillbirths each year</li> </ul>
4.37 4.27 3.99 -P+0.04	<ul> <li>Reduction in stillbirths linked to GAP uptake doi.org/10.1002/uog.22187</li> <li>There was an overall decline, associated with better protocols &amp; awareness</li> <li>NHS Trusts that followed GAP guidance achieved significant further reduction</li> <li>Steepest drop observed in units with best SGA detection rates</li> <li>However study also highlighted that there is much more room for improvement</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Sustained reduction in stillbirths also seen in Scotland <u>doi.org/10.1002/uog.22100</u></li> <li><u>Latest NRS data (to 2019)</u> show continued drop to lowest ever levels</li> <li>Report included data from the 12 (of 14) Scottish Health Boards in the GAP program</li> <li>At least one Scottish Health Board amongst best performing units in the UK</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>COVID-19 and fetal growth surveillance</li> <li>We are monitoring national GAP data during the pandemic, and salute the many frontline professionals providing best possible care under challenging circumstances.</li> <li>To date, there appears to have been no significant effect on overall stillbirth rates</li> <li>There was a slight drop in SGA detection from April but this is starting to recover</li> <li>The best performing GAP units continue to record SGA detection rates of over 60%</li> </ul>
Power Bl	<ul> <li>Automated GAP reports</li> <li>Our current reports are being enhanced by a 'Power BI' reporting system</li> <li>The new functionality, accessible within GROW, to be launched November 2020</li> <li>It will provide unit level information for each NHS Trust and Health Board, with GAP metrics including also information required for NHS England SBL-CBv2 reports</li> </ul>
